ABSENCE DURING TERM-TIME

We have seen a huge increase in the number of holiday requests this term. We need to remind parents that fines will be issued by the local Authority for any absence over 3 days now - and parents should note that fines are increasing to £80 per pupil, per parent.

We are a <u>nut free school</u> due to several children having allergies to various nuts. Please don't send in any nut products including chocolate spread.




BLAST.
